MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL

CITY OF BELLVILLE

1. 5:00 P.M. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Joe Ed Lynn called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

2. INVOCATION AND PLEDGES OF ALLEGIANCE

Alderman Wayne Browning led all in prayer and Pledges of Allegiance.

3. CERTIFICATION OF A QUORUM

Present-to-wit: Mayor Joe Ed Lynn, Aldermen Douglas Lottridge, James Harrison, Wayne Browning, Don Allphin, Alderwoman Donna Jacob; thereby a quorum was established. Also present were City Attorney Charley Smith, City Administrator Shawn Jackson and City Secretary Betty Hollon.

CONSIDERATION TO ADOPT AGENDA

The motion was made by Alderman Browning and seconded by Alderman Lottridge to adopt the agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

CONSIDERATION TO APPROVE MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

The motion was made by Alderman Lottridge and seconded by Alderman Allphin to approve the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of January 21, 2014 as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

6. CITIZEN'S FORUM (Any public comment that is made on an item that is not on the posted final agenda will only be heard by the City Council. No formal action, discussion, deliberation, nor comment will be made by the Council.)

Mr. Robert Winkelmann representing the Austin County Fair Association spoke to Council regarding the ball fields at the City Park. The Austin County Fair Association would be interested in acquiring this property from the City.

7. QUESTIONS AND COMMENTS FROM MAYOR/ COUNCIL MEMBERS/CITY ATTORNEY (DISCUSSION IS LIMITED TO STATEMENTS OF POLICY OR STATEMENTS OF FACTUAL MATTERS, OR THE REQUEST THAT A MATTER BE PLACED ON THE NEXT MEETING'S AGENDA)

Alderwoman Jacob requested a follow-up on old business be included in the City Administrator's Report. Alderwoman Jacob also inquired on public restroom signage and asked for additional lighting at the minipark restroom area. Alderman Allphin informed Council he would be absent at the April Meeting. The motion was made by Alderman Harrison and seconded by Alderman Lottridge to approve the Municipal Maintenance Agreement, Resolution and Ordinance prepared by TXDOT outlining the responsibilities of both the State and City to maintain a safe and satisfactory highway system within the corporate limits of the City. Motion carried unanimously.

12. CONSIDERATION TO ABANDON EASEMENT AT AVENUE "C" AND ANY RELATED ACTION NECESSARY

The motion was made by Alderman Lottridge and seconded by Alderman Harrison to abandon the easement at Avenue "C". Motion carried unanimously.
